



Have you lost your job after March 15th OR are you unable to find work because of COVID-19?

The Canada Emergency Response Benefit (CERB)
may provide you with temporary income support.

**The CERB provides \$500 a week for up to 16 weeks.
You must re-apply to keep the payments coming.**

Apply to the CERB Benefit if:

- You are at least 15 years old
- You have stopped working because of reasons related to COVID-19
- You had income (part-time, full-time or self-employed) of at least \$5,000 in 2019 OR in the 12 months prior. Students who cannot find work may apply
- You have not quit your job voluntarily
- You had no income for 14 days consecutively
- You may still earn up to \$1000 per month while collecting CERB
- If your EI benefits have been exhausted, you can apply
