

The Worker Emergency Bridge

is a one-time payment of \$1,000 for Nova Scotians who are laid off or out of work because of COVID-19 https://novascotia.ca/coronavirus/worker-emergency-bridge-fund/

Eligibility

You may qualify for the Worker Emergency Bridge if you:

- are a Nova Scotia resident
- are 18 or older
- were employed and laid off, or self-employed and lost all revenue because of
- COVID-19 on or after 16 March 2020
- •earned between \$5,000 and \$34,000 in 2018
- have applied (or plan to apply) for the Canada Emergency Response Benefit (CERB)

Before you apply

When you apply, you'll need to provide documentation about your income and your employment.

If you were employed and laid off

You'll need a copy of your Record of Employment (ROE). You should have received it from your employer. You can also view it online through your My Service Canada Account.

- Gather the supporting documentation you need for your application.
- Call 1-800-863-6582 to speak with a Canadian Red Cross agent. Agents are available 7 days a week (including holidays), 8am to 8pm.
