- 4 Leaving the bathroom door open after taking a shower.
- 5 Using blackout curtains which can help block the heat of the sun.

PEST CONTROL

You can minimize pest-related issues by taking a few easy steps including:

- Keeping your indoor and outdoor spaces clean and clutter-free.
- Reporting any issues with windows and doors to your Resident Manager.
- Taking out the trash regularly, keeping sinks empty and storing food properly.
- Closing your balcony door if you notice bees, flies and mosquitos.
